

# Enable Push Notifications on iPhone or iPad

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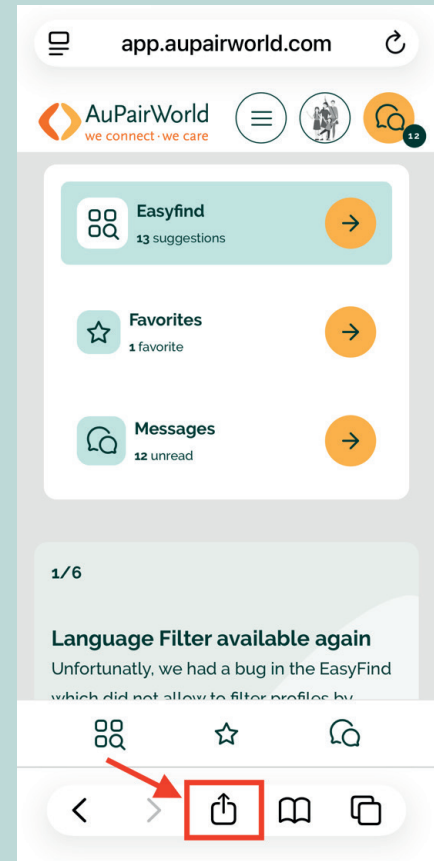
With push notifications, you will get a message right away when you receive a new message – even if Safari is not open.

### Requirement:

You must be logged in to your **AuPairWorld dashboard** at **app.aupairworld.com/dashboard**

### Step 1: Open the dashboard in Safari

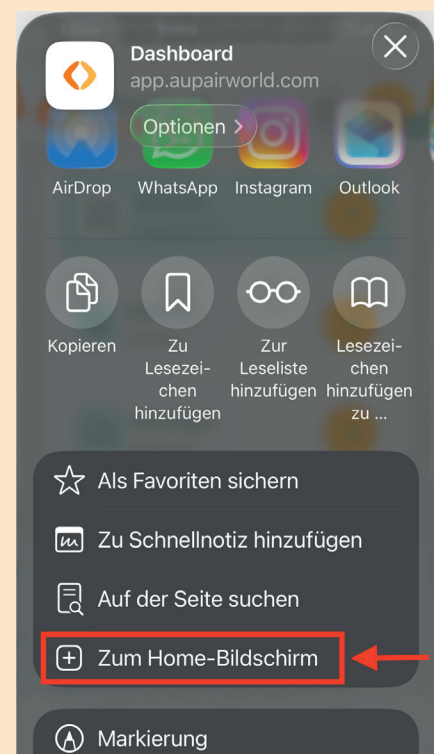
1. Open **Safari** on your iPhone or iPad.
2. Go to **app.aupairworld.com** and log in to your dashboard.



### Step 2: Add AuPairWorld to your Home Screen

To receive push notifications, you need to save the dashboard as a web app on your Home Screen.

1. Tap the **Share** icon at the bottom of Safari.
2. In the menu that appears, scroll down and tap **Add to Home Screen**.



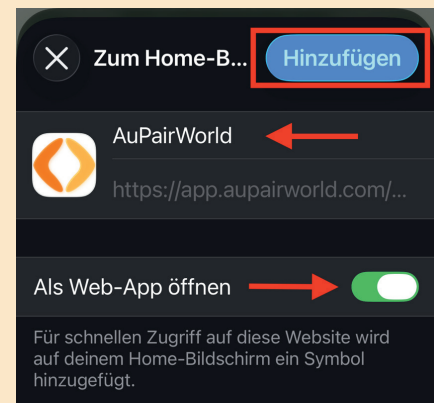
### 3. Tap **Add**.

#### Optional:

- You can change the name of the web app (for example, "AuPairWorld").
- Turn on **Open as Web App** (this option is only available for users with iOS 26).



**Advantage of using the web app:** It opens in full screen without the Safari bar and works like a normal app.

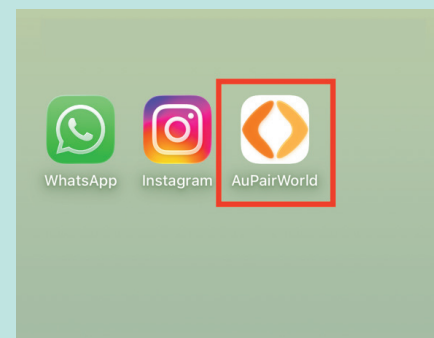


### Step 3: Open the web app from your phone's Home Screen

1. Go back to your **phone's Home Screen** (where you see all your apps)..
2. Tap the new **AuPairWorld icon**.

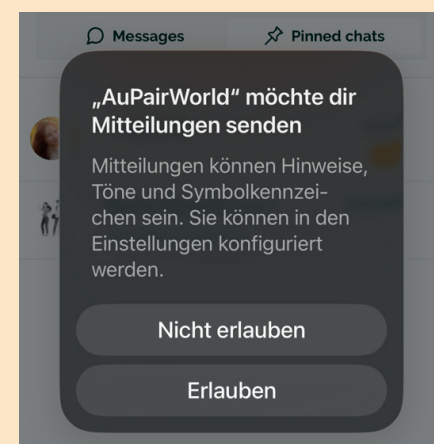
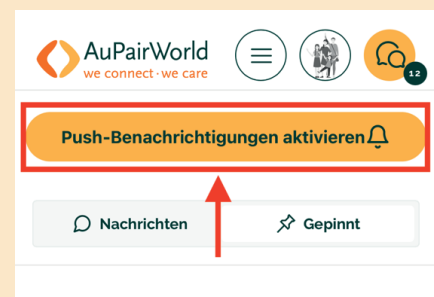


**Important:** From now on, always open AuPairWorld using this icon — not through Safari.



### Step 4: Turn on push notifications in the Messenger

1. Open the **Messenger** in your AuPairWorld dashboard. .
2. Tap the button **Enable push notifications**.
3. Safari will ask if AuPairWorld is allowed to send you notifications. **Tap Allow**.



### Done!

You will now receive a notification as soon as you get a new message.
